

Dear participants of the Summer School,

We are pleased to provide you with the vital information about conducting and organizing of Summer School:

- arrival to the city of Irkutsk on 10.07.17;

- all the participants need to inform the organizing committee about the date and time of arrival so the transfers will be organized;

- departure from Irkutsk to lake Baikal on 11.07.17 at 9:00 a.m.;

- return to Irkutsk on 19.07.17;

- departure from Irkutsk should be planned for 20.07.17;

- dress code: sportswear, warm outwear clothing is highly recommended;

The expected weather: during the day  $20-25^{\circ}C$ 

at night 10-12<sup>0</sup>C

There can be rainy and windy days;

- Each delegation (2-3 students, specializing in mine surveying and geodesy and 1 lecturer) should have national symbols and emblems, including national flag and be ready to perform some national arts;

- Each delegation is required to have 2 laptops at the minimum;

- The participation fee is 40000 roubles (\$ 700) per person. The fee includes travel fare, accommodation and full board, excursions and all arrangements on the programme from July  $10^{\text{th}}$  till -  $20^{\text{th}}$  (the expenses for travelling to and from Irkutsk are not included into the participation fee). You can pay the participation fee on the day of arrival or via bank transfer on your request.

The programme comprises the study and application of the state-of-the-art surveying technologies, such as laser scanning, UAVs usage and GNSS technologies.

The most qualified and well known Russian specialists have been invited to deliver the courses!

At the end of the School period all students will take part in the ISM Final Professional Skills Competition and the winners will be awarded valuable prizes.

Moreover, the cross-country vehicle tours around the unique island of Olkhon, hiking tours and a motor ship trip on Baikal lake are included in the programme. You will acquaint yourself with the history and culture of Russia and the local nationalities of the Baikal region. You will also taste the original cuisine of the Eastern Siberia.
