Study Programs

Within our BA Sustainable Innovative Economics program students learn how to address global economic challenges. Students study to conduct economic analysis, assess risks and potential solutions, cost-effectiveness of projects and programs, develop and implement economic strategies to escape poverty.

Free Software

INRTU students have free access to engineering software on campus, besides that they can also use it at home for academic and project purposes. Our university annually increases funding for the purchase of applied software products to support the educational process, scientific and administrative activities. In 2020, the university allocated about 9 million rubles for these purposes.



RESEARCH

Business Accelerator

Our university holds a series of events focused on the search, development and implementation of innovative technologies to the benefit of companies and enterprises of focused on the search, development and implementation of innovative technologies to the benefit of companies and enterprises of the Irkutsk region. These professional and career support programs are available for students and employees of the university, as well as for people with ideas to create a sustainable business. As part of the INRTU Business Accelerator, participants are provided with the necessary material and technical base for conducting research work, and organizational, methodological, expert and informational support. It also allows to obtain funding for the implementation of developments and subsequent entry into the market in Irkutsk region.

The DAAD Lectorate at INRTU

To promote global education, our university is involved in the initiatives of the German Academic Exchange Service DAAD, where a lecturer of DAAD teaches INRTU students German for free. It provides our students with low family income an opportunity to receive scholarship support and study as part of an international academic exchange at German universities.

Exam Preparation

Our university offers the Successful Applicant program, that enables 11th grade students from all over the Irkutsk region the opportunity to prepare for the Unified State Exam for free. Secondary school students can apply and study online as well. The online courses have significantly expanded the geography of the Successful Applicant program and provided affordable high-quality preparation for the final exams.



OPERATIONS

Student financial support

INRTU has a comprehensive policy for low-income students support. For example, students in difficult financial and life circumstances can receive financial aid. If students have a low income or are eligible for state benefits, they receive regular and increased social scholarships. Every year the university spends about 11 million rubles on financial assistance of low-income and needy students.

Students' Trade Union

Students' Trade Union of INRTU provides assistance to orphans, consults on obtaining benefits, grants free public bus passes, gives New Year gifts for student's children, participates in the distribution of the scholarship fund for low-income students.

Free Vaccine

The university cares about the health of our students, as well as the employees. In this concern everyone can get a Russian coronavirus vaccine for free in the university's medical office.
