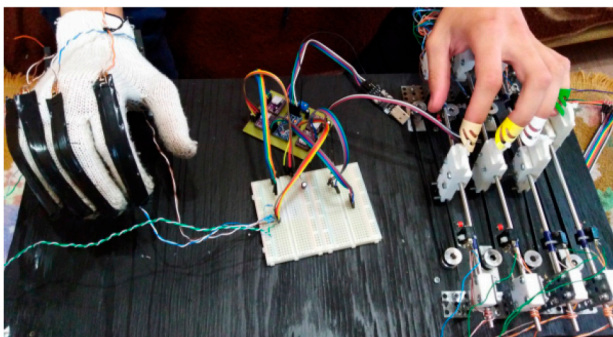

INRTU students and employees of the university can check their blood pressure and temperature and get the necessary medicines and first aid at a medical station of the INRTU Health Technology Center. The station provides free vaccinations against influenza, acute respiratory viral infections and Covid-19. Except the students and employees of the university, family members and anyone else who is interested in it, can get vaccinated.

More than 2000 students and employees were vaccinated against influenza and acute respiratory viral infections in 2020.
