




LEARNING AND STUDENTS

Interdisciplinary Regional Center Invites Professionals to Improve Their Skills

Programs of additional professional education and vocational training INRTU are implemented on the basis of INRTU structural subdivision - Interdisciplinary Regional Center of Professional Development and Retraining of Specialists (IRCPD). The main priority of INRTU IRCPD is qualitative growth of the professional level of managers and specialists, training a new style of thinking, possessing not only the necessary professional knowledge, but also the skills and abilities necessary for the development and implementation of an effective strategy. IRCPD gives specialists and managers the opportunity to be retrained or to improve their qualifications.



Physical Education for Career Advancement

INRTU launched a training program on Theory and Methodology of Sports Training. The graduates will be awarded the qualification of Sports Coach, which allows them to work in sports schools and fitness centers. The project is implemented by the Department of Physical Culture together with the Irkutsk Polytech. The program lasts six months. The curriculum consists of two blocks. Students will study human anatomy, physiology of physical training, sports medicine, basics of physical therapy and massage. In addition, they will learn theory and methodology, pedagogy, psychology, and the legal foundations of physical education and sport.

RESEARCH

Since 1999, the University has been holding sessions of the International Baikal Winter Urban Planning University This specialized interdisciplinary project-educational program is based on 33-year experience of Les Ateliers Internationaux de maîtrise d'oeuvre urbaine de Cergy-Pontoise, which organizational and methodological basis is based on 33 years experience of Les Ateliers Internationaux de maîtrise d'oeuvre urbaine de Cergy-Pontoise (France) - International Urban Workshops of Cergy-Pontoise (France), that allows to search for approaches to finding the best solutions to the most complex and the most pressing issues of regional urban planning policy. The International Baikal Winter Urban Planning University is the only one annual international event in Russia the field of architecture and urban planning.



PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT

INRTU Implements Interdisciplinary Educational Projects

At the program basis the University is actively working with the local community in the framework of many different initiatives, in particular:

- 1 On the base of Tochka Kipeniya the University conducts both systematic and episodic (ad-hoc) online as well as offline events with open access within the walls of INRTU or through the online platform Leader ID.
- Every year the University hosts the international event "Winter Urban Planning University", which is an interdisciplinary educational project, aimed at solving the most complex and urgent problems of regional urban planning policy;
- Moreover, every year the University hosts the championship of professional skills "World skills", that is open to everyone.



Acceleration Programs on Technological Entrepreneurship

Annually the University along with the Fund of Entrepreneur ship Support in Irkutsk region holds various acceleration programs for people who interested in technological entrepreneurship. In 2020 this program was implemented within the framework of the "Taiga" project, its reference is in the evidence.

OPERATIONS

INRTU Implements Interdisciplinary Educational Projects

INRTU held the Ticket to the Future career guidance project. Is is a project of early professional orientation for 6-11 grade schoolchildren. INRTU held 50 events on different topics which were held onsite and online (Try-a-Skill, professional mastery lesson, for advanced and beginners). More than 200 school students from different Russian cities took part in professional tests under the guidance of experienced mentors - Worldskills Russia certified experts.

We organized the Engineering vacations career guidance for 5-11 grade schoolchildren focused on the profiles of the technical university. This time the project was held online. 145 participants from Irkutsk, Angarsk, Usoliye-Sibirskoe, Bratsk, Baikalsk and other settlements of the Angara region have registered on Zoom. The special course of INRTU included an educational program, as well as trainings dedicated to team building, master classes and online excursions.
