The day of the Constitution of the Russian Federation

The solemn event took place within the framework of the All-Russian Student Scientific and Practical Conference "Constitutionalism and Power in Russia: History, Contemporary Problems and Prospects." The organizer of the forum is the team of the Department of Law of the INRTU.

Improving legal procedures

The jury highly appreciated the proposals of the third-year student Dmitry Snetkov, dedicated to improving the structural mechanisms of foreclosure on property in enforcement proceedings. The forum took place at the St. Petersburg Law Institute (branch) of the University of the Prosecutor's Office of the Russian Federation. The student said that he has been researching the field of compulsory execution of judicial and other jurisdictional acts for several years. As he immersed himself in the topic, he had a desire to improve legal procedures, namely, to create conditions for ensuring full and timely execution of court decisions.

PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT

Federal law initiated by INRTU will be adopted by the end of 2020

The State Duma Committee on Education and Science has supported for adoption in the first reading the draft law "On Science and State Scientific and Technical Policy", introduced by Sergei Ten and the deputies of the inter-factional working group "Baikal".

This initiative was developed in close cooperation with the research and teaching staff of our University.

The legislative initiative of INRTU is aimed at improving Article 103 of the Federal Law "On Education in the Russian Federation" and Article 5 of the Federal Law "On Science and Scientific and Technical Policy".

Currently, INRTU employees are working on 14 initiatives aimed at improving the current legislation.

A permanent group of law teachers has been created at INRTU, who develops drafts of legislative acts aimed at improving the legal mechanisms of educational, scientific and innovative activities of universities.



OPERATIONS

Our Anti-Corruption and Anti-Bribery Policy takes a zero-tolerance approach to bribery and corruption.

Our Academic Freedom Policy commits our University to the principals of academic freedom.

The university has an interdisciplinary center for advanced training and retraining of the staff.

The university adheres to the memorandum of non-discrimination in education.

Based on the principles of justice and social equality, the University has a Regulation on Labor Remuneration that guarantees employees a decent wage, as well as the right to encouragement and additional payments.



Students' support
