Open courses of INRTU

Our university provides free access to its educational resources on a special platform open.istu.edu. It's a great opportunity to learn from the best teachers without leaving home and replenish your knowledge and skills using modern technologies. Students can choose a convenient time and study in a convenient place. They independently choose what and how to teach, control the degree of assimilation of knowledge.



Access to library

INRTU library is open for external users; general public gets free access to online andoffline services after registration. In its activities, the Library uses advanced technologies in all library processes. The service is based on Radio frequency Technology (FRID). Free access of readers to the funds of reading rooms and subscription has been implemented. More than 100 automated workstations are organized in the reading rooms for independent work of readers with specialized licensed software installed to perform scientific, term papers and theses.

RESEARCH

Learning opportunities for everyone

INRTU hosts and holds different online and offline free events for general public primarily at Tochka Kipenia space and Leader - ID platform as well as on other University grounds. Within the framework of Russian Science Festival and Russian Science Days INRTU annually holds a series of diverseactivities (lectures, quests, master-classes etc) open for external audience. In this way, the All-Russian NAUKA 0+ Science Festival was held on the INRTU site. This is the key event of the Year of Science and Technology. INRTU has become the site of this largest social project in the field of popularization of science for the 11th time. The purpose of the event is to tell society in a clear and accessible language what science is and what scientists do, how scientific search improves the quality of life, what prospects it opens up to modern man.

Mobile book exhibition

The project for students and teachers of schools, lyceums, technical schools of the Irkutsk region was initiated in 2021 by the university admissions office, center for vocational guidance and pre-university training and Technical library. Last academic year, four exhibitions were organized at the Lyceum of ISU, Lyceum No. 1 of Irkutsk, Khomutovskaya and Shelekhovskaya schools. To dates, the exhibition acquired a permanent character, the exposition was updated taking into account the requests of schoolchildren and teachers. The project "Mobile Book Exhibition "Professions of the Future" and all the materials presented at the exhibition aroused genuine interest among schoolchildren.



Open lessons for teenagers

INRTU continues implementing a program of preparatory courses for those who want to improve their knowledge in various study directions, including creative ones. A week of open lessons on September in 2021 was held by employees of the Center for Vocational Guidance and Pre-university Training of the university. The project motivates children and teenagers aged 5-17 years. The project was timed to coincide with the start of courses on preparation for the state exams. During the week, students got an idea of the teaching methodology and got acquainted with the teachers from our university Within three days, about 100 schoolchildren enrolled in preparatory courses, three groups were formed in general education majors and two groups of children who want to master creative directions.
