

LEARNING AND STUDENTS

Successful completion of training

INRTU has created the conditions necessary for the successful education of students from low-income families, as well as for inclusive education. In 2022 63 students with disabilities, as well as 227 orphaned students are studying at INRTU. If a student is unable to complete an educational program due to family or other circumstances, INRTU is ready to provide academic leave for up to two years in accordance with the regulation on the procedure for granting academic leave.

PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT

Free professional development courses for foreign teachers of Russian language

In 2022, INRTU organized for the first time a free summer school for advanced training of Russian language teachers from Mongolia, where participants were awarded certificates of professional training.



Propredprinimatelstvo

To support the local community in sustainable business development, INRTU organizes competitive and educational business events, where participants can get a grant to develop their business project or, with the support of the university, receive funds from INRTU business partners. Thus, in 2022 INRTU for the first time launched a unique educational program "PROpredprinimatelstvo" aimed at developing entrepreneurial competencies of students.



INRTU Network Lyceum

The university conducts various activities, such as pre-university training and vocational guidance of Irkutsk Oblast schoolchildren within the framework of the INRTU Network Lyceum program.

The program involves training in seven topical areas, including different areas of engineering and IT, biotechnology, law, technological entrepreneurship, economics, and business technologies.



OPERATIONS

Low-income student support

INRTU provides strong and comprehensive <u>support</u> for students from low-income families so that they successfully complete their studies. INRTU students, students in need are provided by the university with free meals, a free set of clothes, shoes and soft equipment, as well as material support for students from low-income families and those categorized as orphans.

Support for students from low-income families

INRTU students from low-income families can receive various preferences in the form of free annual gym passes, sanatorium vouchers, lunches on school days or monetary compensation, increased scholarships, and travel reimbursement. In addition, the university implements many educational programs with trainings on sanitation, drinking water, electricity, and other areas to improve residents' access to these basic services.

Health Fair

Every year the university holds a <u>Health Fair</u>, where anyone can get their eyesight checked and get a consultation from an ophthalmologist and therapist for free, get their sugar level measured, get free vitamins and get the COVID-19 vaccine.
