### Equal educational opportunities

### Participation in scientific events

In 2022 [senior students of the INRTU Institute of High Technologies took part](#) in the II All-Russian Olympiad in the discipline "Processes and Apparatuses of Chemical Technology". The intellectual tournament was held at the Russian Chemical Technology University named after D. I. Mendeleev. The aim is to support talented young people in doing science at a professional level. 55 students from 14 universities of Russia showed interest in the competition. The results were summarized in individual and team scoring.

The team was awarded certificates and gifts.

### Equality in competitions
