BIM - Competence Centre

Due to high demand on usage of BIM technologies (Building Information Modeling) in Eastern Siberia, a BIM - Competence Center in INRTU was created on the basis of the School of Architecture. Construction and Design. The main goal of the Center is to train personnel capable of working in both construction and IT-technologies spheres. The center's activities are focused on in-depth study of theoretical and practical skills of teachers and students. Moreover, INRTU provides comprehensive BIM training in two master's degree programs - "Innovative technologies in technical operation of buildings and urban engineering systems" and



"Building and structure information modeling technologies". A professional retraining program for students on information systems and technologies in construction was opened in 2022.

Annual Rector's battle of Scientists
