

LEARNING AND STUDENTS

Study programs

INRTU offers its students the following programs: Jurisprudence (civil law profile and criminal law profile) and also National Security Legal Support (state-legal profile). These study programs include in self-set educational standards of higher education (Bachelor's and Specialist's degrees). Such competencies are ability to apply the foundations of legal knowledge in various fields and ability to shape intolerance to corruption. The Department of Theory of Law, Constitutional and Administrative Law trains graduate students in the field of Jurisprudence: Constitutional Law; Constitutional litigation; municipal Law.

Implementation of Educational Programs

One of Associate Professors of INRTU became a finalist in the Innopolis University competition for the best <u>implementation of work programs in academic disciplines</u>. The author presented an improved version of the lecture course Information technologies in legal activity.



RESEARCH

INRTU students take part in different scientific conferences, Olympiads and <u>competitions</u>. As a result, the winners receive diplomas. They are able to use their diplomas when applying for a rating scholarship, etc.

The results of the regional Olympiad History of formation and development of procuratorial bodies in Russia have been summed up. The intellectual tournament was timed to the 300th anniversary of the Russian department. The project is organized by the Department of Legal Theory.

More than 50 students of higher educational institutions of Irkutsk, mastering legal specialties, showed interest in the Olympiad. The participants competed on March 11 in online format on the university platform.

Workshops



Scholarships

INRTU students who are actively engaged in science are invited to participate in the competition for a governor's scholarship.



Financial incentives are awarded for outstanding achievements in research activities.

Outstanding students, who study on a budget basis, have an opportunity to receive an increased ranking scholarship. Another opportunity is given to the students studying on a <u>commercial basis</u>. They can receive the academic scholarship for their achievements in various fields.

Co-working Center

Tochka Kipeniia is a <u>co-working center</u> that exists for educational and project activities of university students and employees. The Coworking Center <u>implements modern forms of</u> <u>extracurricular activities</u> to develop students' professional competencies. In addition, a coworking center helps university students and staff avoid the problems associated with working at home alone, as well as unpredictable factors. Technopark is another safe platform at INRTU for open and frank discussion at different levels.





Financial benefits

The university makes payments such as incentive allowances and additional <u>benefits</u> to the university staff, based on an effective contracts system of scientific and pedagogical staff. One of the main tasks of this system is the formation of an effective system of material and moral stimulation of the university staff.
