INRTU Library

[Scientific and Technical Library of INRTU](#) is one of the largest university technical libraries in the East-Siberian region. The Library is a member and participant of the Russian electronic consortia. The [Library](#) applies advanced technologies in all library processes. The service is based on radio frequency technologies. Free access of readers to the funds of reading rooms and lending library is realized. More than 100 automated workplaces for independent work of readers with installed specialized licensed software are organized in the reading rooms.

INRTU students have a unique opportunity to gain international study experience by participating in internships and short-term [exchange programs](#) offered by INRTU international office. Partner universities invite our students every semester for a free exchange semester. Summer School in Russian Language for Foreign Students

The [International Summer School of Russian Language](#) is held annually at INRTU. In 2024, 9 students and high school students from Mongolia studied Russian, familiarized themselves with Russian culture, and visited the sights of Irkutsk. This is part of the long-term cooperation between INRTU and Mongolian universities.



Summer School for Russian Language Teachers

University holds free [summer schools for Russian language teachers](#) from Mongolia, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan. The intensive training took place at INRTU Baikal School of BRICS. Participants attended lectures and practical classes, improved their pronunciation skills, and learned new teaching techniques. INRTU teaching staff is actively involved in an educational program which is supplemented by cultural events to introduce Russian traditions, local sights and rich history of the region. The guests are usually given excursions to the city museums, trips to Baikal. [Summer School](#) seminars cover not only aspects of the Russian language learning, but also issues of sustainable development in the region.



INRTU Tochka Kipenia

INRTU hosts and holds different educational online and offline free [events for general public](#) primarily at Tochka Kipenia space and Leader-ID platform as well as on other University grounds. INRTU annually holds a series of diverse activities ([lectures](#), [quests](#), [master-classes](#) etc) open for external audience. INRTU "Tochka Kipeniya" space is open for external audience both as participants of organized events and as organizers of different activities.



OPERATIONS

Access to High-Performance Computing Resources

A [shared access service to high-performance computing resources](#) has been launched at Irkutsk National Research Technical University. The launch of the service is a joint initiative of the Resource Center and the Information Technology Department. The service is equipped with powerful computers, cutting-edge software, and server and network equipment. This new unit is capable of accelerating project implementation and improving the quality of scientific research. The development team plans to expand the equipment fleet in the future. By improving the specifications and capacity of its resources, INRTU will be able to consider offering its shared access service to third-party customers.



Mother and Child Room

A [mother and child room](#) and a short-stay group for [children](#) have been opened at Irkutsk National Research Technical University. INRTU has nearly 12,000 full-time students and more than 1,500 employees. Approximately 9% of these students have children under the age of seven. Consequently, such projects are particularly important for young mothers who combine studying and caring for young children. Such spaces promote [comfortable learning](#) for mothers, their psychological stability, and the development of socialization in their children.
