

## LEARNING AND STUDENTS

### Study Programs

INRTU is committed to the policy of sustainable development, including the educational policy. The key elements of this educational policy of Polytech are the implementation of individual educational programs with a focus on achieving SDG. In view of this, INRTU Department of Theory of Law, Constitutional and Administrative Law trains bachelors in major "Jurisprudence": [criminal law](#) and [civil law](#). Here the students are provided with getting knowledge in Jurisprudence. Two departments at School of Economics, Management and Law train postgraduate students in Jurisprudence: Constitutional law; constitutional judicial process; municipal law and [Theory and History of Law and State: History of Doctrines of Law and State](#). The university has specialized classrooms: a forensic science laboratory and a courtroom, where students acquire skills in working with forensic equipment, conducting a trial and defending their position on a case. Doctors and candidates of science use an individual approach to each student and are proficient in modern teaching methods during the educational process.



Students form the foundations of practical competence in the process of completing an [internship](#), which can be completed in Irkutsk and Irkutsk region.

### Olympiads and Competitions in Education

During 2024 School of Economics, Management and Law organized [the regional Olimpiad](#) dedicated to the 160th anniversary of judicial reform in Russia, the annual Olimpiad in [the Theory and History of State and Law](#). University Olimpiad, International Law Olympiad. The teams participate in the intellectual competitions, demonstrated a high level of legal training and the ability to apply international law norms to complex and current situations. The events were also supported by the regional branch of the Association of Legal Historians. The aim of Olympiads is to enhance the professional development of future lawyers and to reinforce the knowledge gained during their studies.



An open dialogue between INRTU students and the [Commissioner for Human Rights in the Irkutsk Region](#), Svetlana Semenova, took place on March 12, 2024. The event was organized as part of the project The President of the Russian Federation – Guarantor of Human and Civil Rights and Freedoms. At the beginning of her speech, Svetlana Semenova shared the audience with the work of the Office of the Commissioner for Human Rights. The main task of this state body is to assist in the restoration of violated rights across a wide range of issues, including situations at the intersection of interdepartmental interests.

### RESEARCH

Irkutsk National Research Technical University hosted the [4th All-Russian Conference](#) Person, Society and State Security: Legal Problems and Prospects. Participants proposed introducing a license for scooter riders, discussed extremism prevention, and the role of digitalization of citizen patrols in maintaining law and order.

### PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT

The Irkutsk Region Employer Forum commenced at INRTU on March 1, 2024. The event was attended by representatives of industrial enterprises, government bodies, public organizations, and scientific and educational institutions. During discussions on working with the region's workforce potential, participants emphasized the importance of career guidance and enhancing the role of mentorship. Additionally, the parties agreed to cooperate in establishing educational-production clusters and a corresponding set of events.



### OPERATIONS

#### Awards and Scholarship



Every year, IRNTU students who are successful in their studies and have no academic debts receive state academic scholarships, and Polytech also prepares [pleasant bonuses](#) for talented and outstanding students. In addition, every Irkutsk National Research Technical University student is eligible for a city mayoral scholarship (for research work), Potanin Foundation [scholarship](#) (for master's students), and Russian state scholarships (academic, social, presidential, and government). These awards reward research, academic achievement, and social support.

### Co-working Center



The advanced training program - Terrorism Prevention has finished at INRTU [co-working](#). The program aimed to equip participants with knowledge on the concept of terrorism and its modern manifestations, the principles, legal foundations, organizational forms, and methods of activity employed by federal executive bodies, executive bodies of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation, and local self-government bodies in the sphere of countering terrorism in the Russian Federation, including the forces and means at their disposal. It also sought to provide students with primary skills for solving practical tasks related to countering terrorist ideology. All participants successfully completed the program and received certificates.

### Financial Benefits

The university makes payments such as incentive allowances and additional [benefits](#) to the university staff, based on an effective contracts system of scientific and pedagogical staff. One of the main tasks of this system is the formation of an effective system of material and [moral stimulation](#) of the university staff.
