Successful Completion of Training

[INRTU has created the conditions necessary for the successful education](#) of students from low-income families, as well as for inclusive education. In 2024, 100 students with disabilities and disabilities, as well as 224 orphaned students are studying at INRTU. If a student is unable to complete an educational program due to family or other circumstances, INRTU is ready to provide academic leave for up to two years in accordance with the regulation on the procedure for granting academic leave.

INRTU Discounts

For students from low-income countries, the university provides [tuition discounts](#) of up to 80% and reduced fees for undergraduate, graduate, and postgraduate programs in English and Russian.

PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT

Free Professional Development Courses for Foreign Teachers

INRTU hosts annual summer schools of Russian language for students and teachers from various countries. Accommodation and studies are provided free of charge. Programs for teachers are aimed at advanced professional development, programs for students help to enhance the proficiency in the Russian language.

Both immersive programs combine advanced academic training with cultural experiences in Irkutsk region. In 2024, INRTU also organized a two-week [summer school for 12 mathematics teachers](#) from Mongolia.



Participants honed their skills in information technology integration for math education, including digital tools, coding for classrooms, and data analysis software.



Startup as Diploma

[The "Startup as Diploma" program](#), launched at INRTU in 2020, allows final-year students to develop their innovative ideas into viable businesses and submit them as capstone projects. To date, 87 students have successfully completed the program, including 42 who graduated in 2024. The program has earned international recognition, with five startups successfully defended by graduates from China in one of INRTU's academic schools.



OPERATIONS

Low-Income Student Support

INRTU provides [strong and comprehensive support](#) for students from low-income families so that they successfully complete their studies. INRTU students, students in need are provided by the university with free meals, a free set of clothes, shoes and soft equipment, as well as material support for students from low-income families and those categorized as orphans.

Health Fair

INRTU has established a cherished tradition of hosting the ["Health Fair,"](#) where anyone can receive free health checkups, consult with a psychologist, and speak with an insurance specialist.



These events are essential for students and staff, as they enable early detection of health issues and encourage greater self-care.



Support for Students from Low-Income Families

INRTU students from low-income families can receive various preferences in the form of free annual gym passes, sanatorium vouchers, lunches on school days or monetary compensation, increased scholarships, and travel reimbursement. In addition, the university implements many educational programs with trainings on sanitation, drinking water, electricity, and other areas to improve residents' access to these basic services
